SUMMARY:

A right arm plus two bones from the wrist, completely skeletonized with no soft tissue surviving.

As established from anthropology examination, the remains were from an adult, someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries or any other findings, apart from evidence of burning of the anorak he or she was wearing.

From this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
