AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A largely complete body but missing the head, left arm, right hand and occasional bones from the chest and spine. The remains were completely skeletonized, with no soft tissue surviving. There were additional rib and skull fragments from another person or persons mixed in, one of them young.

As established from anthropology examination the main remains were from a male adult, between the ages of 24 to 60, who measured from 172 to 188 cms in height. There were no other identifying features.

There were no injuries or other findings in the parts of the body present and so from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
