## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

### **SUMMARY:**

The lower part of a body only – part of the pelvis, both legs and the right foot. The remains were skeletonized apart from a little greasy material still adherent.

As established from anthropology examination the person was a male adult, aged between 31 and 71, and measuring from 168 to 184 cms in height. There were no other identifying features.

There were no injuries or other findings, apart from some burning of his clothing. From this examination it is not possible to give a cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **GL05 090BP** was:
