**AUTOPSY REPORT**  
GLOGOVA GRAVE SITE

**SUMMARY:**

A complete body missing only some of the bones of the left hand. The remains were partly skeletonized, but there was a substantial amount of soft tissue still attached.

As established from anthropology examination, this was a young man, aged between 15 and 25 and measuring from 176 to 192 cms in height. There were no other identifying features.

He died probably from a gunshot injury to the trunk which had disrupted two of the bones in the middle part of the spine, albeit with no residual bullet fragments left behind.

The only other injuries were two fractured ribs at the front of the right side of the chest, but most likely these occurred post mortem from crushing or moving of the body.

Apart from burning of some of his clothing there were no other significant findings.

**CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **GL05 110B** was:  
**Gunshot wound of trunk**
