**SUMMARY:**

An almost complete, disarticulated and skeletonized body, in clothing.

As established from anthropology examination, the person was male, aged between 17 – 23 and measured from 174 to 188 cm in height. There were no other particular identifying features.

The investigations showed fractures of the left part of the mandible, of the left scapula, of the 8<sup>th</sup> left rib and of the 3<sup>rd</sup> right rib.

The skull was extensively fragmented. It was difficult to say what caused these different fractures or whether even they occurred before or after death, for these reasons, the cause of death in this person is unascertained.

The only other finding was evidence of some burning of his clothing; presumably something that occurred post mortem.

**CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **GL05 146B** was:  
**Unascertained**
