A right ankle and foot, still in a boot, partly skeletonized but still with some soft tissue attached.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
