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**Summary:**

Fully skeletonized human remains with some clothing, and a bullet. In addition to the main skeleton, which is almost complete, few commingled bones and a partial denture were present. Anthropologically determined sex of the main individual was male, estimated age is 40-50 years and the stature is 169.9+/-7.7cm. Other than some bone loss due to decaying process no fractures to the skull.

There were two probable ante-mortem fatal injuries, one to the chest and the other to the pelvic region, both are of high velocity type bullet injuries probably inflicted from behind. Even though they are fatal injuries the deceased may not have died instantaneously after sustaining them. Whether the fractures found in the right sided ribs and the 13th vertebra (the additional one) are post mortem or antemortem cannot be determined. The fracture of the shaft of tibia is a blunt force type injury, and may or may not be an ante-mortem injury.

**Cause of Death:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **RV02 / 353B** was:

**Multiple high velocity bullet injuries to the trunk.**

The  $3^{\text{rd}}$ ,  $4^{\text{th}}$ ,  $5^{\text{th}}$ ,  $6^{\text{th}}$ ,  $7^{\text{th}}$  ribs were at the curvature. The injury consistent with high velocity bullet injury.

**H. SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

Fully skeletonized human remains with some clothing, and a bullet. In addition to the usual skeleton areas is almost complete from comminuted bone and a partial denture were present. Aethroponology determined sex of the male individual was male, estimated age is 40 - 50 yrs and the stature is  $169.3 \pm 7.7$  cm. Other than some bone loss due to decaying process no fractures to the skull.

There were two ~~possible~~ <sup>probable</sup> autemortem fatal injuries, one to the chest and other to the pelvic region, both are of high velocity type bullet injuries probably inflicted from behind. ~~The~~ <sup>Even though</sup> these are fatal injuries the deceased may not have died instantaneously after suffering them. The fracture found in the right shoulder ribs and the 13<sup>th</sup> vertebrae (additonal one) are either post mortem or ante mortem injuries. The fracture of the shaft of tibia is a blunt force type post mortem injury which may ~~have been an antemortem~~ <sup>occur</sup> or may not be an autemortem injury.
